What the City Run stands for and how to take part:

- Hanau's annual City Run was initiated in 2001 with the goal of raising awareness about violence against women.
- The run is organized by: the City of Hanau, the Main-Kinzig District, the 1st Hanau Running Club, and the Main-Kinzig Sports Association.
- Proceeds from registration fees and donations help support the local womens' shelters in Hanau and Wächtersbach every year.
- The charity run takes place every year on the third Friday in September in Hanau. Both the start and finish lines are set up on Hanau's market square.
- The course is 6 km long and runs through the city of Hanau.
- A maximum of 3,500 runners can participate.
- The registration fee is €12 per participant.
